Registering to Vote



You only need to register once - you do not need to register separately for every election. It usually takes about 5 minutes.

You must register again if you've changed address, name or nationality.

You can also use this service to:

- change the way you vote for example in person, by post or by proxy
- get on or off the <u>open register</u>

You may need the following, if you have them:

- your National Insurance number
- your passport if you're a British citizen living abroad, and want to vote in England, Scotland or Wales

You need to be on the electoral register to vote in elections and referendums and attend Parish Council Meetings.
